GLOBAL EDUCATION & SCHOLARS PROGRAM

The Global Education Program deepens students' awareness of their place and responsibility in an increasingly interconnected world. Students have the opportunity to take part in exchange programs with Jesuit partner schools (Milan, Ireland, Rwanda, Tanzania, Australia) and travel as part of cultural and ecological programs (Belize, Costa Rica, Thailand, China, Guatemala, Italy, Cuba, Galapagos, Canada, Hawaii). Select students who were accepted into the Global Scholars Program participated in round table discussions on global issues, engaged in virtual exchanges with international partners, completed a school-wide awareness campaign and a Global Ed research project. These students received the academic designation of *Global Scholar*.
