"As one gets older and acquires more understanding of one's place in the world, it's natural to reminisce on times that truly stand out and the people that shape one's identity," reflected Chris Santomero '87. "It is this memory of Fordham Prep that I want others to benefit from, experience, and then pass on for generations." In this spirit, the Class of 1987 celebrated its 25th Reunion in April by launching the "Class of 1987 Endowment" to build permanent capital for need-based financial aid. The record-shattering 88 Reunion attendees kicked off a fundraising season that as of September had yielded over \$715,000 in pledges from over 110 class members.

The Class of 1987 Endowment was formed in memory of seven deceased classmates: Louis Block, Dennis dePierro, Michael Grogan, Erik Hernandez, Frank McCaffrey, Anthony Silverio and Steven Swandiak. Need-based financial aid from the Endowment will be awarded as "Patrick S. Joyce Jr. '88 Scholarships"

to honor the Yonkers firefighter who gave his life in the line of duty to rescue others in a tragic 2009 fire.

A variety of motives drove the Class of 1987 to create this unique structure. As mentioned, the effort was formed to memorialize and honor men who have passed. Classmates also considered their own experiences at Fordham Prep, where the intense education combined with broad socioeconomic diversity reflects the school's Mission. There was a desire from the Class to give back, and do so in a way that engaged Fordham Prep's strategic plan for financial aid. And there was the goal to partner creatively with the Class of 1988 on a multi-year effort.

In their own words, class leaders described how these diverse motives came together to spark the Class of 1987 Endowment: "Memorializing our deceased classmates and honoring Pat Joyce, a true 'man for others,' is a wonderful



Chaplain's Corner God loves me as I am: My personal graced history by Father Donald Devine, S.J.

It can be good on a regular basis to look back over our lives with our memory and imagination, our mind and heart to recall Jesus' promise: "I shall always be with you". Psalm 139 might be a helpful scripture passage in remembering God's loving presence.

Recall people I have known (parents, siblings, teachers, friends). Recall their voices, how they loved and affirmed me as well as challenged and helped me to grow. Remember past successes and events I am still trying to find meaning for. Let one memory touch another, notice my present feelings and thoughts as I look back with God's help.

Reflect on my many gifts and the times when I was most conscious of God's presence, as well as the times when I felt very much alone, as if God were very far away. Ask God to show me how He has constantly been with me, not only at isolated times and events but also as my always present trusted companion and guide walking before me and beside me.

When you have finished reflecting upon and praying over the above, it may be good to move on to the New Testament, Luke 12. 22 ff. Here Jesus invites us to observe the Autumn mums appearing among us or recall the lilies of the field or roses on campus. As you look, consider the following:

LOCATION: the flower did not choose this spot, this soil, its neighbors that grow around it, some of them more beautiful than itself; I cannot control my birthplace, ethnic origin, color or height. How much of my life is my making; how much God's?

WEATHER: rain or drought, I must simply stand and endure. I cannot control international cartels poisoning the air, people drugging themselves and filling my neighborhood with violence and fear; child abuse, male chauvinism and strident feminism do not go away;

NATURE OR NURTURE: I did not select my parents, my brothers and sisters, my economic background, much of my educational history, my IQ or musical/athletic talent, the color of my eyes or neighborhood, my parents' friends or my relatives. How much of my life's growth and small world is my making; how much God's?

For all that, not even Solomon dressed up in gold-embroidered brocade was any more lovely than the lily or mums or rose I started out looking at or remembering. For all that has shaped or misshaped me, for all that has given me health or inflicted sickness on me—I am still precious in the eyes of God, and God loves me as I am. This news is almost too good to be true. What more could God do after sending His Son to give up His life to show God's love for me?

We all have room for growth, areas for improvement, dreams and goals and visions to reach and stretch for. But God does not say, "I'll start loving you when you finally get there". He loves me here and now. God would be happy were I to slough off my selfish sins. But these are trash compared to God's creative love for me, the love that will burn them away like fallen leaves or flakes on the bark of a flaming pine log.

Twenty Years of Service in Appalachia and Beyond

Twenty years ago in the winter of 1992, ten students and then Biology teacher and swim coach Bill Fife set out for a week in the Appalachia Mountain Region of West Virginia. They spent the week with other high school students from around the country at Nazareth Farm, a catholic community whose mission is to provide high school and college students with an "experience of church while working to serve the needs of the poor through home building and home repair projects". They spent the week building, not just homes, but relationships with those they came to serve, discovering that many had as much, and at times perhaps even more, to offer them. They learned that the people of the Appalachian region, while lacking the riches of this world, were rich in spirit, faith and friendship. They lived the week in simplicity- sleeping on rope beds, bathing in a creek, and making use of the only plumbing available in an outhouse. Living without modern conveniences challenged them to develop a greater appreciation for the many gifts in their lives. In sharing prayer together each day, they were able to recognize God's abiding presence in their work, in the people they served, and in those with whom they lived that week.

In an article Mr. Fife wrote upon his return from the trip he stated that "We departed West Virginia on February 22nd after having a learning experience of generosity, simplicity and beauty. We returned to the Prep to share this experience with others." It would have been hard to imagine at the time that what they would share would begin a Prep tradition

work being done by these organizaof service that has seen approximately hospices and hospitals and with

1500 students make similar journeys in the past twenty years to destinations that include Laconia, New York; Harlan and Louisa, Kentucky; Robbins, Tennessee; Puebla, Mexico; Duran and Quito, Ecuador; and Camden, New Jersey. Over these years students, faculty, and alums have provided approximately 5000 hours of service in these communities, working on over 150 homes and numerous community projects. In Tennessee alone, the Prep has funded and built eighteen new homes and contributed to the construction of dozens more. At sites in Mexico, Ecuador, and Camden, the service has expanded to include work with children at schools and day care centers, with seniors at

the homeless at soup kitchens and shelters.

In addition to the contribution of time and labor, Prep students have also contributed significant financial support to organizations including Nazareth Farm, St. Francis Farm, SWAP (Sharing with Appalachian People), CAP (Christian Appalachia Project), Rostro de Cristo, the Working Boys Center, Community Links International, the Romero Center, and Appalachia Habitat for Humanity. Through bake sales, raffles, poinsettia sales, dances, car washes, and the generous support of family, friends and benefactors, participants have raised close to a million dollars in these years to support the good

tions. We are grateful for the many students who have been participated in these projects and for the generous faculty, staff, and alumns who have supported this program.

This past summer, 137 Prep students participated in one of eight service trips and fundraised just over \$188,000. While they now enjoy modern conveniences such as indoor plumbing (and even air conditioning in Tennessee) the same spirit of living the week in service, community, simplicity, and prayer still remains. And too the same mission – to share our life and love with our brothers in sisters in need. May God continue to bless this work.

Put simply, the \$2 million contributed to the Annual Fund and Annual Scholarships pays for the financial aid needed by over a third of our families. The endowment fund can only cover about \$650,000 of the \$2.6 million in financial aid and scholarships.



This summer, Father Boller and I attended a one-week meeting in Boston. It was run by BC High, held at Boston College, and was called the International Colloquium on Jesuit Secondary Education (ICJSE). This was the first-ever global meeting of Jesuit secondary schools in the 450 year history of the Jesuits. ICJSE seeks to strengthen the global network of Jesuit schools by providing a venue to share ideas, discuss common strengths and challenges, examine our Jesuit mission and identity, and focus on how Jesuit school educators can prepare students to become global

In a video at the beginning of the conference, Superior General Adolfo Nicolas, S.J., head of the Jesuits stated, "The enormous challenges to Jesuit education today require our best efforts in order for us to serve the mission that has been entrusted to us. By gathering as a global body of Jesuit secondary schools for the first time, we can begin to establish ways of collectively preparing our students and school communities to address the ... welfare of the entire world and its development in a sustainable and life-giving way."

Almost 400 educators from 61 countries on six continents were in attendance. There were many talks and break-out sessions. José Mesa, S.J., Secretary for Secondary and Pre-secondary Education for the Jesuits, gave several

During the Colloquium, we were reminded that Saint Ignatius saw the enormous apostolic potential of secondary education and that secondary education continues to be a crucial apostolate of the Jesuits. However, it was pointed out that Jesuit schools have become so successful (recognized for excellent academics, education of the whole person, and outstanding programs in fine arts and athletics), that there is great temptation to become too comfortable with these successes. The risk is that we will miss opportunities to change and grow. Thirty years ago, Superior General Pedro Arrupe, S.J. challenged the Order to shake its walls, look outside and open our spirits, and to keep pace with the changes in the world.

At the recent General Congregation 35, the thirty-fifth gathering in the history of the Jesuits, it was clear to the representatives of all Provinces in the world that we face new challenges and frontiers. We live in a global world of great interdependence. Globalization is a reality. We cannot allow ourselves to become complacent or too comfortable with our successes. The Jesuits have always operated on the frontiers in the service of faith and the promotion of justice, establishing dialogue with cultures and other religions, and caring for the environment which is part of God's creation. For us, the new frontier is the entire world. We must be willing to renew both our schools and ourselves as educators in order to create schools which truly work to make our students global citizens.

In some ways, this is simply a return to our roots. Networking has always been a hallmark of the Order. Ignatius urged Jesuits all over the world to maintain constant correspondence with the General Curia to create a sense of a universal body. We are following Ignatius' lead by looking to take the largest, and arguably the best, international group of schools and intentionally to develop it into true network.

At the Prep, we have already made some changes to expand our global horizons. We now have a three-year program in Mandarin and, this year, have added Arabic to the curriculum. We are now looking at our curriculum in all subjects to add a global perspective to what we already teach. We are discussing ways to create relationships with Jesuit schools in other countries that will lead to student exchanges, faculty exchanges, and direct communication through technology that will strengthen our language programs and allow discussions on topics of mutual interest. And, we are searching for ways various departments can work on projects with students in Jesuit schools around the world, pooling ideas and data to create joint projects.

This is so exciting because we are taking this informal network of schools which share a common mission and developing it into the biggest and foremost educational system in the world, turning out intelligent leaders who are comfortable with themselves, and who can extend themselves in loving ways to others. Leaders who can think for themselves and not allow others to manipulate them, nor chose to manipulate others for their own gain. Leaders who are not dog-eat-dog competitive but rather competent, cooperative, decisive young men and women who compete with a moral sense. Leaders who recognize that they are working for the greater glory of God.

"Honoring the memory of Pat Joyce and our deceased classmates through a perpetual Endowment for need-based financial aid is in seamless alignment with the Ignatian principle of service to others, going right back to our student service requirement," said Tom Giordano '87. "Many of us felt compelled to be a part of this Endowment effort."

"It can be hard to realize when you're a student, but so much of our education came from the diversity in the student body," commented Pat O'Brien '87. "This socioeconomic diversity doesn't just appear, you have to dedicate resources to fund it, and that's a crucial part of this effort." "It means a lot to know that my contribution to the Patrick Joyce Scholarships will honor Pat as well as help other young men have the opportunity to benefit from the experience of attending the Prep," said Jim Falco '87, "especially as we pass the torch to Pat's Class of 1988." Added former Trustee Rob Ford '87, "Our class has historically shown leadership and generosity and has stayed well connected over the years. As this Endowment passes to Pat's class and beyond, we hope to extend this approach to a much wider audience."

The Class of 1987 will continue fundraising within their 213 members until the Thanksgiving handover to the Class of 1988. Collaboration among the classes sets the stage both for increased participation rates and for outreach beyond the traditional donor base. The Class of 1987 Endowment is designed to link diverse stakeholders across multiple interests. By working together as a team, these groups are building something more meaningful than any individual group working alone. "Helping students in need will exponentially affect so many others for years to come," concluded Santomero. "In so many ways it clearly will be the best investment I've ever made."

WCBS Radio 880 AM profiled the Class of 1987 Endowment on August 20, 2012. In the "Stories from Main Street" feature, reporter Sean Adams highlighted the tribute to Patrick Joyce through a series of on-air interviews with his family and friends.

As heard on the radio: "Most of us were Bronx blue-collar kids, and if we can help relieve the middle class parents for some of the strain of the tuition, let's do it", said Noel Firth '87, who wrote the first check. "It's all about the caring component of who he was, and, and that will reverberate through the next generation and the generation after that," said Patrick's cousin John Joyce '88.

A Real Hero Patrick S. Joyce Jr. '88

In the early morning of October 2, 2009, Firefighter Patrick Joyce '88 was killed in the line of duty "on a report to help others," in the words of Yonkers Fire Commissioner Anthony Pagano. "Pat was a firefighter's firefighter. Fearless, brave, dedicated, loyal, committed. A real hero."

During his too brief 39 years, Pat Joyce played many roles beyond heroic firefighter. He was a loving husband to his wife, Tara, and a devoted father to their girls, Isabella and Charlotte. The proud son of Irish immigrants, Pat was a successful entrepreneur, co-founding a number of bars/restaurants. He also lived a life dedicated to helping others.

According to the Ronald McDonald House New York, where he spent so much time with seriously ill children, Pat "had an unusual and immeasurable capacity for giving." To his daughter, Charlotte, "he fixed everything. He made everything better."

The Class of 1987 Endowment has many sources of inspiration, none more important than honoring the principles underlying Patrick Joyce's approach to life. Working with the Joyce family, the Fordham Prep Administration and leaders from the Class of 1988, the Class of 1987 endeavored to create a living monument to Patrick's service in the way he would have—by helping others.

"As a family we are so thankful for these efforts," said his sisters Debbie and Julianne. "We were blessed with Patrick being part of our family. For the students, in addition to receiving need-based financial aid, to learn about Patrick's charitable life will hopefully create a great resource to mold future Fordham Prep students into responsible members of society."

"Like all fathers, I believe it is important to find role models worthy for my sons to emulate," said older brother Martin Joyce '84, FDNY. "If my sons could live their lives as fully and selflessly as their Uncle Pappy, I would be just as proud of them as I am of Patrick." Added Pat's twin brother Peter, who also serves on the Yonkers Fire Department, "Patrick's passing was a profound loss that forced us to confront the reality that life is a defined point in time. Patrick chose to maximize the talents and opportunities given to him and turn them into opportunities for others. He was a man for others."

At its best, the Fordham Prep education works to instill the words of the school's Mission into the behavior of the students. "Patrick viewed his life as being blessed with good fortune," agreed sister Katie. "He did all he could to make the same good fortune available to others."



By providing need-based financial aid in Patrick's name, the Class of 1987 Endowment works to turn the Mission into meaningful action. "We hope this campaign will help make other families' decisions to have their sons attend Fordham Prep less stressful financially," said Patrick's parents Pat and Kathleen. "Like so many others, we sat at our kitchen table trying to find ways to pay the tuition bills. If not for financial aid at the time, the opportunity to send our sons to Fordham Prep might not have been a reality. We are very thankful for the aid so many years ago and are equally thankful to know others will receive the same type of help because of money raised in Patrick's name."

Out in the Rockaways, there is a tangible physical reminder of Patrick S. Joyce Jr. '88. "The community of Breezy Point dedicated a bench with a plaque that reads 'Patrick died the way he lived, helping others," said his sisters Debbie and Julianne. "In the exact same spirit, we are very grateful that the creation of this Endowment will carry on his principle of service to future generations."

To celebrate their 25th high school reunion this past April, John Neary and Donn McNamee wanted to design an endowment for Fordham Preparatory School that would both celebrate a dedication to student diversity and honor fellow Fordham Prep graduate, Patrick S. Joyce.

Maybe it is something about the class of 1987, the spirit of the school or the memory of Mr. Joyce — a class of 1988 graduate and a member of the Yonkers Fire Department who died in 2009 during a call to a house fire — but classmates have come together to endorse this new endowment with some \$650,000 in gifts. The endowment will provide a permanent pool of money for financial aid awards for students in need.

Mr. Neary, who has pledged \$125,000, and Mr. McNamee, who has pledged \$50,000, are old friends who played football for Fordham Prep. They both point to the all-boys Catholic education they received as teens as the turning point in their lives.

Mr. Neary, the son of an NYPD officer, grew up in the Kingsbridge section of the Bronx and received a scholarship to go to Fordham Prep. Upon graduation, he went to Yale University for his undergraduate degree. The 42-year-old managing director at Morgan Stanley is the global head of MultiAsset Portfolios. He is chairman of the board of trustees of Fordham Prep.

Mr. McNamee, also 42, was raised by his mother in Inwood and got financial assistance to attend Fordham Prep. From there he went to Le Moyne College and now works in the natural gas swaps and derivatives group at Newedge USA. Mr. McNamee is a Fordham Prep trustee.

The two say that their class is filled with success stories of just regular boys, the children of working-class parents, who came to a good school in the Bronx and benefited from teachers that "made sure you strived," as Mr. McNamee put it. The 213 graduates of the class of 1987 benefited from the diversity of students with different socioeconomic and ethnic backgrounds, says Mr. Neary, and the endowment is designed to help preserve that mix. Tuition at the school runs \$16,720.

But there was also a desire to honor a fellow Fordham graduate with the new endowment. Mr. Joyce was a popular student at Fordham and his funeral service was attended by thousands. Mr. Joyce lived a "life meant for others," says Mr. Neary, and it is that spirit that they also wanted to capture with the endowment. The scholarships awarded from the endowment will be called "Patrick S. Joyce Jr. '88 Scholarships."

Messrs. Neary and McNamee had no blueprint for starting an endowment, they just "attacked" the list of classmates one by one, says Mr. Neary. A part of their strategy is no special giving tiers and no galas. That the endowment is partially meant to honor Mr. Joyce and other classmates who have died makes it "selfless" says Mr. Neary. Classmates have been generous in response, they say, far exceeding their whispered initial goal of \$250,000. Now, they say, the fund will reach \$750,000 in donations from their class.

by answering some frequently asked questions:

Q. What is development and alumni relations?

A. Development is a broad-based, well-planned effort to increase private funding for Fordham Preparatory School and to support its master and strategic plans. It also assists the Prep in continuing its long-standing commitment to excellence in academics, athletics and the arts.

The goal of alumni relations is to keep alumni connected to each other and to the school. In staying in touch with Prep alumni, our activities include: gatherings in various cities; on campus activities; special events (reunions, Hall of Honor Induction Dinner); and providing our alumni, parents and friends with campus news and materials.

Q. In general, how is development integrated into overall campus planning?

A. To maintain the margin of excellence that distinguishes the Prep, our office plays an integral part in campus planning, as it helps to supply the means for Fordham Prep to expand and grow to meet the needs of its students.

Q. What types of revenue raising programs do you implement?

A. It is important to implement development programs that will maximize philanthropic support for the school. These programs include: annual giving/direct mail, major giving, prospect management, special events, and corporate and foundation relations.

Q. What is Annual Giving and why do we need it?

A. Annual Giving is a basic fundraising program and the key to success for all aspects of the development effort. It is the cornerstone of our fundraising efforts and is designed to help cover the current year's anticipated operational expenses through the school's Annual Fund. Because the Prep's Annual Fund covers immediate operating expenses, it is critical that the Fund remains strong and growing.

Since tuition and earnings from endowments underwrite only a portion of the school's \$17.2 million operating budget, the Annual Fund is critical to the many things that make Fordham Prep an exceptional school. We need to raise approximately \$2.5 million this year to close the shortfall in our budget.

Q. How are the Annual Fund dollars spent?

A. Gifts to the Annual Fund provide unrestricted

support for the operation of the Prep: professional development of our faculty and staff, classroom materials, student activities and clubs, arts and athletic programs, financial aid, and the maintenance of our school.

Q. How are corporations, foundations and organizations identified as potential partners for Fordham Prep?

A. Research is an important factor. There are more than a thousand corporations, foundations and organizations in the tri-state area that contribute to education, all of which are potential donors. In addition to leads from constituents, prospects are obtained from corporate and foundation directories and grant listings in various publications. References from alumni, parents and friends are welcome and frequently successful.

Q. How can I help the Development Office as a volunteer?

A. Perhaps you can: assist us with our Annual Fund outreach; direct us to corporations, foundations and organizations where you have affiliations; participate in a Fordham Prep project, join a committee to help us implement our programs; host a gathering of friends or business associates (presentations will be made by Fordham Prep administrators and faculty).



Father Mallick J. Fitzpatrick, S.J.

Some know Father Mallick J. Fitzpatrick, S.J. as a gamester, others as a train buff, others as a birder, but everyone knows him as a go-getter. Father Fitz combines the influence of his mother's exquisite loving care of the family, his father's devotion and work for the Church and its people, and his sister's social work and personal support of poor and needy youth. When he was only ten he went with his family on a breathtaking train trip throughout the entire West.



It was on that occasion that he felt his vivid imagination come completely alive.

In high school he threw himself into everything, enjoyed the liveliness of his peers and his association with the Jesuit faculty. A growing desire to become a Jesuit was cautioned by the fear that he was being selfish, knowing that it would simply make him happy. That hesitation was put to rest when his Jesuit counselor said "you know God wants you to be happy." His focus became that of the whole person from his first experience as a teacher-coach-moderator at Fordham Prep. His final preparation occurred when he served for a time as an Army Chaplin in Heidelberg, Germany. There he definitively learned that good things would surely happen for people if he simply made himself available.

When he became the Prep's Student Counselor 50 years ago, Father quickly opened up the entire college world to our students. He traveled to all parts of our country, visiting more than 300 colleges, 200 of them for extended periods or many times. Whenever he visited a college, that college started to come to the Prep and kept up a dialogue with Father ever after. Before many books did so, he provided all of our students with his ratings of over 600 colleges along with the recommended department in each. In the meantime, he counseled every student and organized, ran and encouraged college trips. He then armed them with the three times and ways to make a final college decision.

Father applied his notable energy and initiative to another groundbreaking invention. At the time of great national unrest and alienation, with violent protests on campuses, he found many students could not calmly address their current and future lives. For ten years he provided a group guidance retreat house, first on City Island and then in Dobbs Ferry, which was effectively used by students with their counselors in all grades. On the double-overnight version for upperclassmen, he first had them experience a disarming and fun simulation game. These were either of his own discovery such as the famous *Star Power* or his own invention such as *The Way West* and *Lord of the Isles*. This always led to valuable discussions, realizations, reassurance and support.

When the United States quieted down, he moved this program to the Prep building and developed the comprehensive Group Guidance Program still in place today. He and the other counselors continue to fine-tune particular sessions and still play some valuable personal/interpersonal games which either he discovered, such as Counteract, or invented, such as Field of Dreams. This process has consistently helped students "Come into Their Own."

There was a time when students had lighter schedules than today and some seniors found that, when the college application process stopped, *they* stopped ... growing. Father filled that void with an exposure to art accompanying final decision making. His signature piece was having them act out the Greek statues and then applying that 3-D experience to the various 2-D movements in painting. Once technology more than filled this vacuum, he changed the approach by creating an Art Reference Library for the school and an AP Art History course for the most interested. With his several summer visits to Europe and his strong visual memory, Father can make studied art sites and pieces come alive, from sun rise at Mont-Saint-Michel to the setting sun on the Parthenon in Athens.

Above all Father has great appreciation for each student, both for who he is now and what he is trying to become. He has always believed that *everyone* has a vocation...to be found within one's self. Thus, in every yearbook his quote is simply "Become who you are." He only asks that he and everyone continue to grow and become their best selves. He knows that is what God wants.

FORDHAM PREP FOOTBALL:

The Early Years

With the Prep marking 125 years of football this fall, one could easily assume the sport to be among the most venerable pastimes in school history. But with Fordham approaching its Dodransbicentennary (a spectacularly clumsy a word for a 175th Anniversary), there are more than a couple of sports, clubs and activities that were around long before the Maroon 11s ever took the field. As we know, just having celebrated its 150th, Fordham baseball was already decades old before the first touchdown was ever scored at Rose Hill. A debate team, St. John's Debating Society, had been in place for a third of a century before our first football game was ever even played. (In fact, the Prep's Speech and Debate Team still uses the original 158-year-old motto today, emblazoned proudly on their jackets: "Πολεμέω φίλως και νικάω," which translates as "I fight fairly and I win.") And in literary circles, some thirty years before a Prepster would ever run out onto the gridiron, the Prep, then still officially the Second Division of St. John's College, had already seen its first student publication, The Spy, the brief-lived great-grandfather of all Prep student publications today. Nonetheless, with its mythic origins, legendary rivalries and epic heroes, football would come to have an unquestionable hold on the Prep's collective imagination and a unique place in school his-

In 1881, informal games began to be held at Rose Hill. In those days football itself —American football as we know it, that is — was still in its infancy, slowly diverging from rugby and soccer and the other football-type games that preceded it. A year later, Fordham University, then St. John's College, would have its first foray into intercollegiate football, with the establishment of Fordham's first college-level team. By 1883, a Prep team almost certainly existed, if only as a practice squad. More than likely, some of the older Prep boys were even playing on the College teams — the line between high school and college was not always so well defined then.

Though we have no mention of a distinctly Second Division game being played against any other school, twice the Prep appears in University records in the early 1880s as the opponents of the College team in those first few years of its existence — both games: Prep losses.

But then in 1887, after four or five years of embryonic existence, Prep football was born at last, and the records, previously silent on the subject, suddenly speak of a first interscholastic game — "a scoreless game, called on account of darkness," as the story has been passed from generation to generation —in locker rooms, at rallies, and even by the press. A decade before the Fordham Ram would be born of a student cheer, and two decades before John Ignatius Coveney, a College student (himself a Fordham footballer), would pen the Fight Song up in his dorm in Dealy Hall, Fordham Prep would have its first football game. First opponents: who else, but the Boys from 16th Street. As noted by first-year College student David Arellano, Prep Class of 1887, in the "Second Division Notes" of the last Fordham Monthly of that fateful year:

[Ironically, the "game called on account of darkness" occurred the very year that electricity had come to Rose Hill, with electric lights installed in the First and Second Division Study Halls as well as the Student and Jesuit Refectories. {That's irony, right?}]

Prep football struggled at first, competing for student interest and school support with the likes of baseball, which had been the dominant sport on campus for over 25 years. In fact, the first teams had no uniforms, and would borrow from the off-season baseballers. As recalled in the December 1898 *Monthly*, the discussion of football uniforms only came up when it became apparent that the baseball jerseys were taking a beating. As for equipment, beyond the still-roundish, nearly rugby-style ball, it seems that the use of protective gear [straps and earguards or leather helmets] was entirely optional. Only by the mid-1890s would football even begin to take its place as a major

Prep team, and it would not be until the early 1900s that the sport would really come into its own, with Prep teams winning championships in 1904 and 1906 and going undefeated for three consecutive seasons, as noted in 1908 by the *New York Press*.

During this first decade of the 20th century, the first legendary names associated with Prep football begin to emerge. John "Jack" Coffey, for whom the Rose Hill stadium is named, is most often associated with University athletics — baseball, in particular — but his coaching career actually began with the Prep football squad while he was still a student at the College. So respected was young Coach Coffey by his team, that led by captain and quarterback Harry Hamburger, Class of 1911, they would present him with a gold watch fob in 1910 as a token of their appreciation for his hard work and encouragement. Besides our alliterative friend Harry, another name that stands out among the early players is Francis "Bull" McCaffrey, Class of 1907. As a College player in 1909 he would be named Fordham's first All-American. And already on Campus during the Aughts as a Third Divisioner (in those days, Fordham also had a grammar or middle school for younger students), Francis "Frankie" Frisch, Prep Class of 1916, would move up to Second Division in 1911 or '12 and become another of the early Prep football notables. In fact, the nickname that would follow Frisch through his legendary major league baseball career, "The Fordham Flash," was actually earned during his Prep days on account of his speed on the gridiron.

Moderating the fledgling football program that decade was Mr. John L. Gipprich, S.J., a young scholastic. After his ordination, Gipprich would go on to have an extraordinary career in the sciences, becoming a physics professor as well as Director of the Astronomical Observatory at Georgetown. During his Fordham years however, Mr. Gipprich did much to insure that Fordham Prep football would continue to grow and thrive as a school sport. Incidentally, in 1908, he also founded the St. John's Second Division Walking Club, a club that has changed names, fallen in and out of fashion, been forgotten and reborn, but still exists today as the New York City Explorers Club. The club's current moderator, Mr. Paul Homer of the Religion Department, keeps an artifact called the Gipprich Stick, a walking stick carved from a lightningstruck tree over a hundred years ago [or at least that's how the story goes {Remind me to write about that one in a column sometime}]. One last football footnote to the Gipprich years: the following was recorded in a 1907 entry in the Prefects' (Deans') Diaries — "Post cards of 'Fordham Prep Football Team: Interscholastic Champions of New York' issued. Very popular among boys, and in two days more than 400 went out in the mails" [And Your Director of Alumni Relations, Mr. Larry Curran, Class of 1977, thought that maybe he had introduced the concept of the photo postcard to Prep mass mailings.] It is unknown of any of those souvenirs from 1907 still exist.

Despite the many triumphs, those first years of football at Fordham Prep were not wholly untouched by tragedy. In the fall of 1914, **Colin Hays**, an outgoing and good-natured senior and the son of prominent Yonkers coal broker, was caught at the bottom of a pile-up in a game with St. Peter's Prep on October 12, 1914. He died of injuries two days later at St. Francis Hospital in New Jersey, and as a result, Prep football was suspended for the remainder of the season. His younger brother, Raymond, was a second year student at the time.


In the years following the First World War, as Fordham Prep more and more became what we would understand as a high school (as opposed to a college's lower division), so too, Prep football would grow into a modern high school athletic program. In the 1920s and '30s and beyond, we begin to get the familiar names of the Prep football tradition, coaches and players alike, from Mr. "Zev" Graham to Mr. Bruce Bott. Of course, the

stories are myriad: Robert "Alpy" Abplanalp, who in November 1938, during the closing minutes of the final period, cooly kicked the extra point to give the Prep a 13-12 victory; Coach Ososki's '54 Squad and their perfect season, anchored by co-captains Walter "Buzzy" Morris and Mike Siano; the Varsity's Football Team's 2010 record-breaking 10-win season lead by Bronx-Manhattan Coach of the Year, Mr. Peter Gorynski and Bronx-Manhattan Player of the Year, Anthony Bronzo.

To close, one would be amiss to look back over the early years of Prep football without giving a nod to perhaps one of the Prep's most enduring traditions: the Turkey Bowl, Fordham Prep's annual Thanksgiving game against Xavier High School, the Prep's original opponents from 1887. It is the oldest high school rivalry in the City — and among the oldest in the country [and in football, period] — with 88 games in the series to date. 19th-century scrimmages aside, the first Thanksgiving game recorded is the 1905 match-up, a Prep victory 31-0. There were two more holiday games that decade, in 1907 and 1908, the Prep trouncing Xavier in both games, strangely enough by the same score twice: 61-0. The series would pick up again in 1927, after the War, and after the reestablishment of Xavier's football program. Some of the games in the '20s were played on Election Day instead of Thanksgiving (in those days Election Day a major fall recreational holiday), but, nonetheless, the tradition of the holiday game has

And the rest, as they say, is history.

remained unbroken to date.



William Porcaro '67

It could be the fact that his mother attended a grade school in Cleveland named after Saint Ignatius or his attendance at Fordham Prep and Fordham College that made Bill Porcaro live his life as a *Man for Others*. After graduating from Our Lady of Assumption in the Bronx in 1963, Bill came to the Prep where he was a four year member of the Track team. He graduated in June of 1967 and stayed on campus to



attend Fordham College. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree in English Literature in 1972. He decided that he did not want to have a career in business but wanted to work with people in need. His first post-college job was as a vocational instructor and workshop manager at the United Cerebral Palsy Association in Purchase, NY. He became a Personal Adjustment Training Supervisor and Vocational Evaluator at UCP in 1974. After completing his Masters of Education at Hunter College, he became a Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor at the Westchester Association of Retarded Citizens in 1976. "Founded in 1949, ARC of Westchester is the oldest and largest agency in Westchester County serving children and adults who have developmental disabilities and their families." He was promoted to Program Director in 1983 and served in that position until 2006.

After a year as the Assistant Head of School at Cooke Center Academy High School, Bill returned to his Jesuit roots as the Dean of Students at Cristo Rey New York High School, a co-ed school in East Harlem serving low income families. Bill says that Cristo Rey is unique. Students attend classes four days a week then work one day in corporate settings throughout the city. Families pay only \$2,000 a year in tuition, the money that they earn at their jobs goes to the school to cover the cost of their education. Students receive an excellent college prep education while gaining valuable real world work experience. Bill now serves as the Director of Admissions and Athletic Director at Cristo Rey. He is proud to work alongside Prep classmate Tom Sites who is the history chairperson at Cristo Rey.

When looking at his career, Bill says that the faculty at the Prep always provided support and encouragement. "All we were ever asked was to do our best." He mentions Father Mallick Fitzpatrick and former faculty member and coach Tom Byrne '60 as examples of faculty who were very supportive. It was the idea of doing your best that Bill incorporated into his professional life. He worked with former residents of state institutions and community based clients with developmental disabilities providing vocational training, job placement and support services, helping them enrich their lives in the process.

Bill is still involved at the Prep. He is a Class Representative for his class and an annual phonothon volunteer. Bill and his wife Ellen live in the Throggs Neck section of the Bronx and are the proud parents of Lauren, Megan, Kerry and his son Mark, an '00 graduate of the Prep. The Porcaros are also the proud grandparents of nine grandchildren.

Joseph Powers '91

When Joseph Powers started as a first grader at the Annunciation School in the Crestwood section of Yonkers, NY, he started a life long association with Catholic education that continues to this day. Joe came to the Prep in September of 1987 and over the next four years developed an affinity for Jesuit education. After his Prep graduation in 1991, Joe received his Bachelor of Arts degree in 1995 from LeMoyne



College. His first post college job was as a resident prefect at Georgetown Preparatory School in Washington, DC. In addition to his prefect duties, he worked on a Masters of Science degree at Johns Hopkins including student teaching at schools in the Washington, DC area. After completing his Masters in 1998, he became the Dean of the Resident School at Georgetown Prep. He also coached golf, basketball and baseball and served as moderator of various clubs and activities.

Joe is a strong believer in Jesuit education and tries to keep close to his Jesuit roots. He completed the 19th Annotation, which is a compressed version of the Spiritual Exercises. Whether working at Jesuit schools or non-Jesuit schools, Joe teaches with the idea that he is helping create men and women for others.

The sense of community is what Joe remembers most about his Prep days. He remembers fondly his junior year Emmaus retreat, his four years on the baseball team and just sitting in the Commons with his friends and classmates "simply shooting the breeze." When Joe's mother passed away in his junior year, he remembers the support that he received from the students, faculty and staff.

Joe and his wife, Brit-Marie, live in Bethesda, MD with their three children, Madeline, Andrew and Jack. All three children attend The Woods Academy.




Voluntary Support Summary FY 2012
