DEDICATION OF THE

Rowen Athletic Field AND Joe Fox '29 Track

The sun was shining as more than 500 members of the Prep community gathered at the dedication and blessing of The Rowen Athletic Field and Joe Fox '29 Track on Saturday, October 25th. Standing at mid-field, Prep President Father Christopher Devron, S.J. blessed the Rowen Athletic Field by sprinkling holy water on the new FP letters. Next was the blessing of the Joe Fox '29 Track and the new column which recognizes the project's generous donors. Atop the column sits a new bronze ram head.

The plaque on the column reads as follows:

The "back field" was renovated this past summer because the original field and track surfaces began to show the wear of ten years of activity. Parent John Trimble P '16 initiated the project in a conversation with Father Devron. As others, like David Randell P'15, Chief Financial Officer Mike Higgins and Athletic Director Bob McLaughlin joined the team, the scope of the project started to take shape. The group decided that the Prep needed to upgrade the facilities to a level that would be a source of pride for athletes and students. A "wish list of excellence" was developed and the campaign to raise the necessary funds was started.


Construction was started as the 2013 - 2014 school year came to an end. The field was finished in time for the beginning of the 2014 Higher Achievement Program. When HAP ended, the work on the track started and was completed before the fall sports began practice for their seasons.

New features were incorporated into the project that will become a source of Fordham Prep pride for current and future athletes and students. A banner that reads Fordham Preparatory School with the letters A.M.D.G. has been installed on the fence at the Metro North side of the property. The banner says the same thing on both sides and is now visible to Metro North commuters as their train passes the campus. It can also be seen from Webster Avenue. Better storage sheds for team equipment are another addition as



The blessing of the Joe Fox '29 Track






Father Devron blesses the new Rowen Athletic Field

are a new pole vaulting pit and a small set of stands for watching games and meets. Besides being named the Rowen Athletic Field, the new field now has a large FP painted at mid-field. The entire complex has also received a new landscaping design.

Many of the dedication ceremony attendees took the opportunity to take photos of themselves with the new bronze ram. In remarks after blessing the ram, Father Devron suggested that Prep athletes line up to touch the ram and face the school banner for inspiration before they head to games. Father likened it to the tradition of the Fighting Irish football players who reach up to touch a sign that reads: "Play Like A Champion Today" as they ascend the stairs in the famed and historic locker room at Notre Dame Stadium. The difference for Prep Rams, however, is important: We "Play for God's Greater Glory" (A.M.D.G.).

The dedication ceremony was followed by a homecoming celebration that was hosted by the rejuvenated Gridiron Club. The attendees were treated to BBQ food that was freshly prepared in the Prep parking lot the night before the ceremony. At the homecoming, Kevin Rooney '88, the co-chairman along with Trustee Donn McNamee '87 of the Gridiron Club, announced that former coaches Joe "Sammy" Ososki and Bruce Bott '59 will be the first inductees into the new Fordham Prep Football Hall of Fame. Bott also had a distinguished career when he was the quarterback for Coach Ososki (see page 8).

Thank you to all of the people who worked hard to make the field a reality and those who attended the dedication.



Pilgrim's Post

In the early years of the Society of Jesus Ignatius wrote 6,800 letters to his fellow Jesuits, making him one of the most prolific letter writers of any time. Many of these letters were written to Jesuits scattered throughout Asia and Europe and served not only as a way to instruct these young Jesuits but also as source of encouragement and inspiration. He ended each letter with the phrase "your fellow pilgrim," pointing to Ignatius's sense of being on a pilgrimage in this world with his fellow Jesuits. It was one way that these Jesuits, scattered throughout the world, could remain connected to each other as a community. Much like those early Jesuits, our Prep alumni community is also scattered throughout the world but it is our sincere hope that the Prep can always be a source of encouragement and inspiration for you. A new biweekly feature on our website called "The Pilgrim's Post" is one way we hope to accomplish this. Like Ignatius' letters, we hope it will provide you with encouragement, inspiration, and perhaps just a moment of respite in a busy day. Consider these posts Fordham Prep's letters to our "fellow pilgrims."

The first post from the Prep website is reprinted here.

Lord teach me to be generous.

Teach me to serve you as you deserve;
To give and not to count the cost;
To fight and not to heed the wounds;
To toil and not to seek for rest;
To labor and not to ask for reward
Save that of knowing I do your will

St. Ignatius's Prayer for Generosity

Perhaps the most famous prayer associated with St. Ignatius of Loyola, the Prayer for Generosity, has also become well known among Prep students in recent years. It is printed on the back of student identification cards and each day at the Prep ends with the entire community reciting this prayer. While St. Ignatius himself may not have been the author of this prayer, it certainly captures the heart of his spirituality – the desire to know, love, and serve God. Its sentiment can be found in Ignatius' instructions before the Contemplation to Obtain Love, the exercise of the Spiritual

Exercises where he reminds the retreatant "Love should consist more in deeds than in words." Before this exercise, the retreatant is instructed to "ask the Lord for the grace to direct my thoughts, activities, and deeds to the service and praise of His Divine Majesty," echoing the words of the Generosity Prayer.

Evidence of Ignatius' spirit of generosity abounds at Fordham Prep in recent months. This past summer Prep students raised a record \$242,000 through our Service Immersion Program to support the work of Habitat for Humanity in Tennessee and the Working Boys Center in Quito, Ecuador. Prep students only have to walk out to the newly renovated Prep field and track to see the spirit of generosity of the parents and alumni who donated so generously to make this much needed improvement to the athletic facilities at the Prep. Upperclassmen also have shared generously with the newest members of the Prep community – the Freshmen serving as big brothers and tutors. The Freshmen too have been quick to be of generous service to the school, with 113 of them applying to be a part of the new Ambassador Program that will welcome eighth graders and other visitors to the Prep. The many examples of this generosity all point to the spirit of Ignatius that permeates life here at the Prep.

While this prayer may be rather simple, we know that living with a spirit of generosity is not always easy. Our lives can demand so much that at times it may seem we have nothing more to give. We can too easily find our days filled with long to-do lists with little time for generosity. Our culture also at times can lead us to self-centeredness that can leave little room for true generosity and service. Perhaps that's why this prayer is needed more than ever these days. Its words are simple, but its message is profound as it calls us to seek the generosity in our lives that leads to genuine love and service. It reminds us to simply "labor and not to ask for reward," knowing that we indeed can do God's will.

Fordham Prep v. Hunger 2014

Fourteen years ago, Mr. Brian Carney and Mr. (now Fr.) Mike Greco '87 resurrected a campaign to collect food to help those in need. That first year the Prep collected 1,600 food items. Over the years that campaign has grown tremendously (last year the Prep collected over 21,000 food items) and has become an ideal opportunity for members of the Ministry Leadership Team to exercise leadership, increase the awareness of the Prep Community on the issue of hunger, and respond through a massive food drive campaign.

As I write this on our 2nd day of Hunger Awareness month, seniors Ken Knapp and Joe Prunty have already conducted the annual Hunger Banquet for our Freshmen class. They successfully sensitized the freshmen to a global perspective on hunger as 15% of the freshmen were waited on by seniors and fed a delicious and well-balanced lunch, 25% enjoyed a buffet of baked ziti and 60% sat on the floor given only a roll and some water. The freshmen eventually understood the metaphor as they learned how these percentages represented the global reality of hunger.

They were also introduced to their first Hunger Awareness Month at Fordham Prep and to the senior leaders of the food drive, Kevin Sohr and David Vitiello, who informed the freshmen that by November 25th the Prep is striving to collect 22,000 food items. These items will be distributed to Mercy Center, a resource center for women and their families in the Mott Haven section of the Bronx, Concourse House, a transitional home for families who otherwise would find themselves homeless, and Part Of the Solution (POTS), a "one-stop-shop" center helping individuals and families move from crisis to stability to self-sufficiency. This is the highest goal the Prep has ever attempted, but the seniors are confident that they can reach it and are motivated by the fact that 1.7 million New Yorkers live below the poverty line and that 1 in 5 children are born into poverty in NYC. POTS alone served 800,000 meals in 2014. While hunger is a sad reality in our world, in our country and in our neighborhoods, the Prep, guided by our senior ministry leaders, is committed to better understanding it and doing something about it.







The President's Report

We are well into the first half of the school year, and so you may have wondered why Ramview didn't drop in your mailbox yet. We decided to delay our publication date so we could include several exciting developments that we knew would take place later in the Fall.

I have used much of this season to develop my strategic focus for this school year, well aware that we will use this to begin planning for our 175th Anniversary.

As I move into my second year of leadership at the Prep, I hope to help us become MORE! "More what?" you ask?

MORE...

GLOBAL: The Prep has been invited to become an international hub of Jesuit secondary education through hosting a summer global seminar of Jesuit students and educators from around the world. How can we use this opportunity to leverage our global network as a Jesuit secondary school in New York City arguably, the Capital of the World? How can we better initiate and support international exchange programs with Jesuit schools around the world?

ACCESSIBLE: Ignatius Loyola insisted that Jesuit schools serve "rich and poor alike." Because of several factors—e.g., the closing of parochial grammar schools; the cost of quality education; the growing achievement gap based on income; the shrinking middle and working class in New York City— Fordham Prep has seen less and less students from families of modest means matriculate here. How can we better identify, recruit, prepare and offer tuition assistance to these young men? **DIGITAL:** This year, we have launched our highly anticipated One-to-One Computing Program in which each student (with the exception of seniors) brings a hybrid laptop/tablet device to class so teachers may use this resource to maximize and improve learning outcomes. How will we continue to leverage technology, specifically through integrating it into our curriculum? How can technology help us better connect to our global network of Jesuit secondary schools?

TRADITIONAL: At the heart of our tradition is excellence and continuous improvement across every area of the school. Our facilities must also reflect our traditional commitment to excellence. Over the past 8 years, the Prep has invested \$12MM in facilities upgrades, most recently, through the construction of our new Rowen Athletic Field and Joe Fox '29 Track. This year, we are undergoing a comprehensive needs assessment and facilities design process for the entire campus. The purpose is to improve our facilities to better serve the mission of a 21st Century Jesuit secondary school education. Our Ignatian tradition also calls us to a deeper experience of God's presence in all things. Thanks to our new office of Ignatian Formation and Ministry, we hope to provide alumni and parents with greater resources for spiritual formation and the integration of faith and scholarship.

Thank you, as always, for your dedicated support and generous care of Fordham Prep. It is a blessing to partner with you in this transformative mission.



The Principal's Report

On Sunday, November 2, the Prep held its annual Open House. This event is a long tradition and I'm sure many of you remember helping at it. Every year, the Open House undergoes some minor changes. However, this year the changes were much more substantial. At the recommendation of Father Chris Devron, S.J., a committee of parents, teachers and administrators met on several evenings last May and June to review all our Admissions programs and to make recommendations for changes. Mrs. Sheila Sohr, mother of senior Kevin Sohr '15, wife of Mike Sohr '83, and sister-in-law of Bob Sohr '82, John Sohr '86 and Kevin Sohr '93, chaired the committee.

This committee worked hard and made many excellent suggestions. As a result, the Open House had a substantially different look and feel. One simple idea was to make the atmosphere more celebratory. We ordered many balloon columns, arches, clusters, and individual balloons, some maroon and some white, all with the Prep Seal imprinted on them. They decorated the building's exterior, entrance, Hall of Honor, Commons and both Gyms. They festooned the Open House from start to finish.

During the Open House, almost 1700 grammar school students and their families, one of the largest numbers in Prep history, were greeted by Fr. Devron and other faculty members as they entered the Hall of Honor. After gathering in the Theatre, the visitors were organized into groups for tours. These were not traditional tours through the building, but rather trips to locations whose presenters were more focused in offering information about the Prep. For years, the first stop has been to one of several classrooms where five to six faculty would present essentials about the Prep and its programs. Our committee recommended a substantial change in the makeup of the presenters. Upon their recommendation, we reduced the number of faculty presenters to two and added one Prep mother, one Prep father, and one Prep senior. The change was transformative. The faculty presenters were, as usual, spectacular. The parents and students were also. But they added an additional perspective. They spoke of the things at the Prep which they love. The parents in particular were articulate and thoughtful, yet emotional about the many ways they have seen their sons grow into academically accomplished, service-oriented and spiritual young men.

We implemented other changes suggested by the committee which also had dramatic impact. Prep parents, alumni and students were involved in every part of the day. The videos about Prep life, prepared by Prep graduate C.J. Johnson '08 of our Engagement Office, were impactful; the set-up of information tables in our gym was impressive; and the celebratory nature of our Commons was dazzling. Our Jazz Ensemble playing in the Commons was quite impressive.

Perhaps two quotes capture the compelling dynamism and spirit of the Open House. The first, unsolicited from an eighth grader's parent who had no previous connection to the Prep:

I believe his positive experience was a direct result of an extremely well organized open house program which was concise and provided a clear picture of how a Jesuit education is like no other in that it develops all aspects of a young man's character, not just his academic skills for college. I found the program was well organized and, most importantly to me, communicated the message of how special a Jesuit education is in developing young Catholic men for not only college but for their responsibilities as members of our larger society: service.

The second, from a Prep teacher, after working at the Open House:

The comments from parents and their sons were overwhelmingly positive. Everything I heard was positive: "I am blown away by this school." "This is such an exciting place to be. I can feel the positive energy everywhere." "All of the other Open Houses pale in comparison to this one." "I loved this school when I was a student here, and I want my son to have an even better experience than I did. I didn't think that was possible, but after today, I know it is." The core values of this school are still the same as when I was a student here. Now it is a school in the 21st century offering quality Jesuit education." "This school was the best thing that ever happened to me. Seeing it today reminds of the gifts Fordham Prep gave me over 20 years ago. I want the same for my sons."

Yesterday was my proudest moment ever as an educator. More importantly, yesterday reconfirmed why every day I look forward to the trip to the Bronx to be with my Fordham Prep family and boys. This is a magical place committed to excellence *in every aspect of Jesuit education.*

Thanks to our dedicated members of the committee, to our gifted faculty and to all our alumni who spread the word about this unique Jesuit school in the Bronx.



MULLALY & **MULCAHY:**

The Messenger & The Medalist

The 1914-1915 school year saw the return of Fr. Charles Mullaly, Jr., SJ to Rose Hill. Born in Washington, DC on September 19, 1877, Mullaly had first come to Fordham as a young scholastic in 1906, teaching Latin and Greek on the Prep level before leaving to complete his theological training in preparation for his 1911 ordination. Returning to Fordham in 1914, Fr. Mullaly would assume the role of prefect of discipline, or dean of students, at both the College and the Prep.

In those days (a few years before Fr. Arthur Shea would become the Prep's first distinct prefect), the high school boys were generally shepherded by a rotating staff of scholastics appointed as assistant deans, with Father Prefect himself overseeing the college men directly. During the two years of his prefecture, however, the frail, stern, yet kindly Fr. Mullaly was not only beloved of the students on all levels, but took a particular interest in Prep

Though conflict had already broken out overseas by the start of the school year, wartime austerity had not yet come to Fordham, and so, campus athletics were in full swing — plenty of Prep games for Father to drop in on. Nonetheless, the Prep would not be wholly untouched by tragedy that autumn.

On October 12, 1914, Colin Hays, an outgoing and good-natured senior and the son of a prominent Yonkers coal broker, was caught at the bottom of a pile-up in a game with St. Peter's Prep. He died of injuries two days later at St. Francis Hospital in New Jersey. Prep football would be suspended for the remainder of the season. The November issue of the Fordham *Monthly* of that vear contains a formal resolution of condolence from the Class of 1914 to the parents and younger brother of their departed teammate, classmate, and friend. Colin's brother, Raymond, was a sophomore at the time.

A few weeks after the tragic accident on the gridiron, Fr. Mullaly would also be on hand for a much happier moment in Rose Hill athletics: the celebrated founding of Fordham crew, the centennial of which we mark this season. Fr. Mullaly was not the only former Fordham man to join the faculty that semester — John "Jack" Mulcahy, Prep Class of 1891, would also make his return to Rose Hill late in 1914 as a member of the coaching staff, bringing with him an expertise in rowing renowned worldwide. Mulcahy was not just your ordinary early 20th-century crew coach, he was an Olympian, Fordham's first, having taken both gold and silver in separate events with rowing partner

After his championship years, Jack and his wife, Katherine (née Vilsack) would settle down back in New York, where the internationally recognized oarsman would return to Fordham with the intention of forming Fordham's first rowing team in 1915. From the very beginning, Prep boys would be involved.

As the *Times* unmistakably reports: "Mulcahy has advised the Fordham Prep youngsters to organize, too." With practices starting soon after Christmas, the Prep and College teams were competing in regattas by the spring — rowing was huge in those days, and New York was its American epicenter. As expected, success was scant for the neophyte Fordham teams at those first outings, but, as they say, a good time was had by all. The inaugural season of Fordham rowing was capped off with a race between the Prep boys and the College men on the Harlem in June 1915 — the younger Fordhamites were given a three boatlength head start. No record of who won.

Unfortunately, the newly-founded rowing program would never have a chance to get its sea legs, as it were. All too soon, the War would come to Fordham, and, like so many of the Rose Hill extracurriculars in those days, rowing would give way to the war effort. Nonetheless, in a short period of time, the formidably-willed Coach Mulcahy had brought rowing and its culture to the school and established an enduring legacy at both the Prep and the College.

Rose Hill rowing's hiatus would continue until after the Second World War, with a College squad heading back to the river in the late 1950s. For decades, Prep crew would exist informally, with the occasional Prepster piggybacking along with the College men, or in the form of rowing clubs loosely connected to the school in one way or another. At this point, the story of Fordham Prep sculling gets fairly sketchy for sure. [In fact, if anyone out there can fill in the blanks, a quick note would be very much appreciated — and send pictures!]

Under the leadership of Coach Norm Hildes-Hein, and his captain, Bob Giusti, Class of 1972, a formal attempt at a Prep crew team reboot was undertaken in the early '70s, as Frank Valentinetti, Class of 1974, has recently recalled on Facebook: "Forty-two years ago, [our] crew team began and ended when our borrowed shell was broken — by others!"

Finally, in 2000, Coach Mulcahy's vision would be fully established on account of the persistence of rowing enthusiasts

William O'Connor, Class of 2004, and Christopher Clark, Class of 2003. They brought their hopes of starting an official Prep team to Mr. Ted Bonanno, the crew coach at the University. Bonanno would offer an eight, oars, a launch, and help finding a coach. Coach Damien Isabella would direct that first 21st-century team, assisted by Coach Anton Dengler, Class of 1997, with Mr. Kevin Pigott as the club's faculty moderator. Eleven Prepsters would row on the Harlem that season as Fordham Prep Crew was reborn. The generosity and support of the Prep crew parents in those first years of the millennium were an incredible force propelling the program forward, so much so that by 2004, under Coach Sid Iyer's guidance, Billy O'Connor, classmate Ryan Ujazdowski, and the rest of the team were already proving the relaunched program a potential powerhouse, taking gold and silver at the New York States Championship Regatta in Saratoga Springs.

Today, 100 years after the Times first announced Coach Mulcahy's plans, Coach Larry Muri's roster of 43 Prep crewmen is stronger than ever, recently achieving unprecedented success in front 300,000 spectators in Boston at the prestigious Head of the Charles, the world's largest regatta. The Prep Varsity Eight, racing in the men's youth eight event, finished in 27th place among 85 entries, posting the 15th fastest US high school time — the best finish at the Boston regatta by any Fordham Prep crew to date — and earning an automatic invitation back for the 2015 meet. In the proud tradition of their Olympic founder, the team is regarded as one of the best high school teams in the country. Indeed, John Mulcahy's spirit and love of the sport endures and thrives.

And though in a very different way, the legacy of Mulcahy's contemporary, Fr. Charles Mullaly, SJ, also still endures. Father's 1914-1916 stint as dean a century ago would not be his last stay at Fordham. After some time in Jamaica as a missionary, the former Fordham prefect would again come home to Rose Hill, this time taking up what would be his life's work: the production and publication of popular Catholic literature, most notably, the Messenger of the Sacred Heart, a nationally distributed devotional monthly. One of Father's first tasks upon his third Rose Hill tenure was to construct the stone building on Fordham Road that would house his presses. Today, that building is known as Murray-Wiegel Hall, where some of the Prep's Jesuit fathers take up residence in their well-deserved retirement.

FORDHAM TO ENTER THE ROWING FIELD

John J. Mulcahy to Coach the Crews—Call for Candidates After Christmas.

Fordham University will enter another department of sport. This was announced yesterday when plans were formulated for the adoption of rowing by the Maroon collegians. For the last few years, especially since a number of rowing stars have come to the Fordham Law School, a plan has been under way to rouse spirit enough to get rowing on a real basis, and the backing received from a majority of the active alumni at the annual Winter meeting was all that was needed. Following the meeting last week the alumni promised their support, and as a result a meeting of the undergraduates will be held this week to get out candidates.

Rowing has been a big topic at Fordham for some time, as a result of the campaign which was started by John J. Mulcahy, a member of the class of 1894. Ever since leaving the university Mr. Mulcahy has been a notable in rowing circles, and he reached national reputation when, teamed with William Varley, he won the senior doubles cham-pionship at the Olympic games in St. Louis in 1904. Since then he has figured prominently in several title events, and at the present time is President of the Atalanta Boat Club, the oldest organization of its kind in America. has held this office for six years. late he has been giving most of his attention to coaching, and he developed the crew of the Atalanta Club which made such a fine showing under the captaincy of "Tom" Thorpe, the former Columbia star, two years ago.

Mr. Mulcahy because of his interest in aquatics has received the promises of help from several of the alumni, and besides offering to coach the crews of Fordham, has offered his Alma Mater the use of the Atalanta Clubhouse at 152d Street, on the Harlem River. Recognizing the difficulties which will face him, Mr. Mulcahy has made plans for the use of the four-oared shell only, and if successful, will introduce an eightoared boat later. During the coming year he proposes to hold nothing but interclass and interdepartment races

and a schedule is now being arranged.

It is not expected that Fordham will enter the intercollegiate work for at least a year. In his effort to develop as much material as possible the Maroon alumnus has advised the Fordham "Prep" youngsters to organize also.

Work will begin after the Christmas holidays, when the call for practice will be issued, and Mr. Mulcahy is confident of gettting out a good squad.

A Man for Others Peter Mach (Minh Huynh) '91



Peter Mach visited the Prep this Prep with his brother Jim and reunited with two of his former teachers Assistant Principal Dennis Ahern '63 and Barbara Reynolds.

My name is Peter Mach, but all my teachers and friends from the Fordham Prep years (1987-1991) know me as "Minh Duc Huynh" or just "Minh." I recently visited the Prep for the first time in a very long time during July of 2014. Thanks to the arrangements made by Mr. Curran, whom I fondly remember as a student, I felt honoured to have a tour of my beloved school from my wonderful former English teacher Mr. Ahern. I was thoroughly impressed by the old and the new at the Prep. The cafeteria is still the same as I remember it. Many of my teachers are still working at the Prep 23 years after my graduation – Mr. Ahern, Mr. Curran, Mr. McNamara, Mrs. Henry, Mr. Gomprecht, Father Fitzpatrick, Mr. Beck, etc. My inspirational Latin teacher Father Lombardi is apparently now the pastor at St. Anthony's Parish. About the new (at least new to me), the theatre looks stunning and the adaptation of the latest technology in the classrooms is ushering the Prep into another new era. I felt like a student again walking through the hallways, which are now decorated with photos of each graduating class. Of course I had to stop to take a photo of the class of 1991 so that I can try to recall the faces of all my classmates. It is also pleasing to learn from

Mr. Ahern that while the Prep has grown in various ways over the years, it continues to make an effort to keep the student body as diverse as possible, especially along ethnic and socio-economic lines. I was also very happy to see Mr. Gomprecht and Miss Joan Wollman in the administration offices, where I used to work after school as part of my work-grant program from the Prep. Mrs Reynolds, the moderator of the Asian Club when I was the president, soon arrived at the office and we all shared good laughs together. Though she has retired from the Prep already for a number of years, I started keeping in touch with her a few years ago after I founded a non-profit organization called AMA. Mrs Reynolds has become a kind and gracious donor to AMA for two years in a row without me ever asking or expecting it. The irony is that I structured AMA in a way that has allowed me to honour teachers like Mrs Reynolds, who has sacrificed and given so much to their students and society as a whole. In the midst of our group conversation, AMA naturally came up as a topic and I shared its history and vision with the group.





About AMA:

I founded the "Agliardo Mach Award" (or AMA) in 2012 to support educational causes in Vietnam. I became financially independent and wanted to realize my own dream of helping others in need. The Fordham Prep message of being a "man for others" has always been ingrained in me. Having grown up poor in Vietnam and in NYC as a refugee, I also always wanted to do something in my adult life to give back to society because I feel so lucky and blessed. During my busy years as a finance professional and entrepreneur in Hong Kong and Singapore, however, I never had the time to explore philanthropy on my own. When I decided to slow down in 2011 to spend more time with family and to explore my personal interests, I started asking the right set of questions during my travels. One day on a trip to Ho Chi Minh City in Vietnam, I heard from my good friend Huong about the plight of many of the college students at the

University of Education in the city. I learned that this university attracts largely poor students, especially from rural areas of Vietnam. Many people in Vietnam do not want to become teachers, despite the fact that teachers are highly respected in the local communities. The reason is simply low pay at around USD 120-150 per month, which is not even enough to support one's living expenses in this big city of 10 million. I then learned that most of these poor students still attend this university to become teachers because the government makes it tuition-free (tuition is USD 500 per year, which is expensive for the poor). There is an understanding that these students will work for the government's public schools for 5 years as their pay-back period. After graduating, they need to apply for teaching jobs through the government and wait to be placed at some school beyond their control. Often times, they get sent to rural

areas where the environment can be extremely challenging for a number of years. I could imagine why teaching can be such an unattractive job given the low pay and an uncertain future. I decided to book a meeting with the university and ultimately met with the vice-principal Mr. Nghia and the head of student affairs Miss Phuong.

Over the course of the next 6 months, I learned more and more about this university of 18,000 students and gradually designed a scholarship program to help its students and teachers. I realized that they can really use my financial support because they start poor as prospective teachers and will likely stay poor after they enter the workforce as actual teachers given such low salaries. I wanted the university to take me seriously since it is their first time dealing with an individual rather than a corporate donor, so I pledged 4 years of support from the

beginning so that we both take a longer term approach with this relationship. Based on the school's feedback, I priced each scholarship amount by estimating each student's financial burden per year so as to help them cover their living costs. The parents of these poor rural families simply cannot afford to support their children and as a result most of the students work odd jobs or do tutoring after school so as to cover their own college expenses (very similar to my story when I was studying at the Prep!). The students have to pay for their own housing cost too (only 350 of the poorest students can get subsidized housing from the university), with many of them riding a bike for an hour each way to get to the university. Some of them even need to send money home to help out the family because they are so poor. I also learned the following Vietnamese saying after spending enough time on campus:

give some of the scholarship money to his

"The student is dead if he doesn't get admitted into university, while the family is dead if he does." This quote means that the student brings shame to the family if he does not make it into university; but if he does, the family goes broke from financing his educational costs and also from losing his earnings power during his years in university. The deeper I dug into the issues, the more I realized how much I can help to improve the lives of these students and teachers. I set the following selection criteria for our scholarship recipients:

(1) they must be poor and show official proof of poverty, since the poor need the most help; (2) they must demonstrate and maintain strong academic results; and (3) they cannot be recipients of multiple scholarships in a single academic year, since I wanted to make sure that the money is going to people who really need it most. By the end of 2012, I sponsored my first class of scholarship recipients: 10 students studying for their BA and 5 existing teachers/lecturers at the university. BAs get 4-year support, MAs get 2 years, and PhDs get 3 years.

Before I met the 2012 class of recipients at the award ceremony, I came up with a name for the award in order to honor the two most influential people in my life: my adopted father Minh Mach and Father Michael Agliardo, S.J., who was responsible for getting me admitted into the Prep in 1987. I named it the "Agliardo Mach Award" or AMA, without telling Michael at first (he insists that I call him Michael and not Father Agliardo). Eventually, I had to approach Michael about the scholarship program since it had his good name on it. I also asked him to write a short summary about himself and/or our friendship, with the goal of motivating these students to believe in the importance of teaching. I also wrote my personal essay to share my life story with these recipients, so as to give them hope based on my own success as a result of having a good education. I wanted to encourage these students to complete their degree, because many of them do drop out due to their difficult circumstances at school or at home. My brother Jim (who joined me for the Prep visit and the lunch with Reynolds) dropped out of New York University after his freshman year for the same reasons, because we were so poor and he wanted to help out the family financially by going to work instead. It is so impressive to me that Jim got admitted into NYU after immigrating to the USA for only 2-3 years and speaking no English at first. It is very unfortunate at the same time that he chose to drop out due to financial stress at home. When Jim walked through the hallways of the Prep with me and Mr. Ahern, he said he wished he had gone to a school like the Prep. It broke my heart to hear it and I am in tears whenever I think about it, but it is part of the reason why I am supporting these students in poverty through AMA. Smart and diligent students deserve better; they have already worked so hard all their lives to get admitted into a good university. When I met these 15 recipients for the first time, I enjoyed a 2-hour question and answer period with them in a classroom. It was both tearful and joyful for me. They already read the essays that Michael and I had written for them, which became "the AMA story" for donors and recipients of later years. While I answered all their questions and heard their stories, I also saw myself in them and identified with them. I was once poor like them, strug-

gling in life and not knowing what the future brings for me or my family. Like them, I was not even sure if I would attend university or complete my college degree. I could have been a street boy in Saigon, or a gangster in NYC. Yet, thanks to people like Michael and all the great teachers in my life, I live the American Dream today. I wanted to help these recipients realize their Saigon Dream with financial and motivational support from

Russian studies in all of south of Vietnam in her first year of studying the language! I was proud and Michael was impressed. These were not just poor students, but also very bright and driven. Michael and I spent lots of time sharing thoughts with one another and he suggested that I think deeper about what I have at hand and how to make a more meaningful impact through AMA. He emphasized quality over quantity. He also brought up the approach of developing a whole person from

To make a long story short, a few friends back home in Singapore heard about my work and decided to volunteer financial support. For the first time, they heard about my personal life from the AMA story, which is slowly becoming semi-public information among some friends, though I never really shared it with friends at school or at work until recently. I felt a bit vulnerable for opening up in such a way, but it did help raise USD 80,000 in two weeks. In August 2013, I took the plunge and decided to form a non-profit organization in Singapore called AMA Vietnam Ltd, which is 100% charitable. Infrastructure was built around the organization and it has grown very fast since. I recruited many friends to join me as volunteers. In less than one year, we have become a company with 16 people. With the e xception of our local Coordinator, all of us work for free because we care about the cause. We are now expanding into two other cities in central Vietnam, offering another 55 scholarships in 2014 to take the cumulative total to 108 recipients by the end of 2014.

My wife and I together with another couple fund the operating expenses of the company so that 100% of donor's money can be given to the recipients. We allow donors to have naming rights so that they can honor important people like I did. We provide donors with files of information on their recipients, including personal essays. We connect the donors to their recipients in various ways if donors choose. Basically, we have created what I would categorize as "intelligent and mean ingful giving," where donors know exactly where their money is going and that the impact is meaningful over time. My personal argument is that I am the living proof that this model works given a certain amount of patience and diligence. I'd not be here today in such a privileged position if it wasn't for all the "angels" intervening in my life, offering me hope and support in their own ways.

I owe Michael again for his idea of humanistic education during his visit to Vietnam in 2013. I invited Michael to Vietnam from Loyola University in Chicago so that he can see AMA's work for himself and meet the recipients. I thought it would be meaningful for him and our recipients and I was right. He had a wonderful exchange with the students, especially when he spoke a bit of Russian to one of our freshman recipients who actually became the #1 ranked student in

various angles, rather than just through financial and motivational means. I understood it because that is what he and Fordham Prep did for me. However, I knew that it required more resources and dedication from the AMA team. Once again, I took the plunge again and designed our Mentoring program for the recipients. We subsequently introduced a lunch series where experienced teachers were invited to a luncheon with all of our recipients. On each table, we planted two experienced teachers from local schools with 8 AMA recipients so that they can have a meaningful exchange, where the students can ask any questions they want. For example, the teachers discussed about the challenges they face in their jobs, or how jobs in certain schools can be found, etc. AMA now offers a Mentoring program for BA students and a separate forum for MA/PhD lecturers since they differ in age and experience. We have wonderful volunteers who contribute to these events. We are also exploring other ways to help each person develop as fully as possible.

One other recent exciting development at AMA is the involvement of the great Italian opera singer Andrea Bocelli. By chance, I got to meet a close friend of Andrea and a member of the Andrea Bocelli Foundation. His name is Alessio and he is a friend of a friend in Singapore. Thanks to my friend, I had a nice lunch with Alessio and told him about AMA's work in Vietnam. I also mentioned the fact that AMA is supporting 5 blind recipients in our program. In particular, one blind recipient named Tam is such a talented musician that he can play 4-5 instruments. Tam has 10 siblings and 5 are also blind. He somehow manages to take the bus to school daily. After school and f he has time, he begs on the street for money by singing and playing his guitar. Tam is an excellent singer too. During our award ceremony in 2013, he performed a few songs and put everyone literally to tears. There was absolute silence in the room when he finished singing. I was in tears and so was the vice-principal sitting across from me. In my first year of awarding scholarships in 2012, Tam actually turned down my award, though unknown to me at the time. When I found out later and asked why, I learned that it was because he could not satisfy one of my criteria, which was not to give money to family members because I want them to spend it on their educational needs. Because he wanted to

mother to help out the family living in poverty, he was honest enough to turn me down. Of course, once I heard about his story from the university, I immediately called him back and gave him the award, granting him the option of allocating some of the scholarship money to his family if he chooses. I was so impressed by his integrity alone. He could have lied to me but didn't. He was born blind but yet so capable and independent. Because I gave to Tam, in the following year AMA attracted 8-10 blind candidates. I think the word got out that I was willing to support the blind and there are about 40 blind students in this university. I learned that many people do not want to support the blind because they think their money is better spent on the abled rather than disabled. After interviewing many candidates, we happily supported another 4 blind students in 2013. They are smart enough to get into the university and they can use the help from us to finish their degree. In total, I told Alessio that AMA now supports 5 blind scholars at the University of Education and that we have plans to support more in the future. Alessio left for Italy after that lunch. I did not expect anything nor did I know anything about the Bocelli Foundation at the time. I treated Alessio like any other potential donors, who are usually my close friends and now friends of friends (I do not raise money from the general public). Alessio emailed me after a few days, saying that Andrea and Veronica like what AMA is doing in Vietnam. I still did not know what to expect. After a few more days, Andrea himself wrote an amazing 2-page letter to our recipients, with personal words of encouragement and a sincere sense of hope. I was deeply touched and impressed by him and his wife Veronica. They are obviously extremely caring people with big hearts for fellow human beings in need. His words filled my heart with warmth and I got the letter translated into Vietnamese for all of our students and teachers to read. I don't know what will happen next between AMA and the Bocelli Foundation, but I look forward to finding out. Perhaps we can start a program to support the blind in Vietnam, above and beyond our university campus. Perhaps we can fight more poverty together. Whatever it is, I took forward to creating more meaningful and sustainable ways of giving and making impact. Giving and especially giving through education is now a living part of me and a tradition of my Jesuit friends such as Michael. It is also my way of respecting the values instilled in me by the teachers of Fordham Prep. In honor of all my former teachers at the Prep, I will donate enough money to AMA to name a scholarship after every one of my beloved teachers from the Prep over time. I miss you all and hope to see you again one day, especially my soccer coach Mr. McNamara, Mr. McCormack, my math teacher Mrs. Henry and my guidance counselor Father Fitzpatrick, without whom I would not have applied for Columbia University.

Fordham Prep Football HALL OF FAME Established

The Fordham Prep Football Program dates back to 1887. It is estimated that during the course of the last 127 years, over 3,000 students have played football for Fordham Prep. Recognizing that after 127 years, the establishment of the Fordham Prep Football Hall of Fame was clearly overdue, Fr. Devron blessed its creation at a meeting of the newly revived Fordham Prep Gridiron Club in June of this year.

At that now historic meeting, approximately 30 alumni, administrators, coaches and parents came together and unanimously voted to induct two men as the first members of the Hall of Fame. These men were chosen because they each demonstrate the finest qualities

of someone who is worthy of induction and will serve as a high benchmark for future inductees to follow.

Without further ado, the 2014-2015 Fordham Prep Football Hall of Fame Inductees are Joseph Sammy Ososki and Bruce Bott '59.

In March 2015, at a time and place to be determined, the Prep will host the Football Hall of Fame Ceremony and formally induct Coach Ososki and Coach Bott into the Hall. Until then, permit us to share with you a few interesting facts about Joe Ososki and Bruce Bott.

JOSEPH SAMMY OSOSKI

Joe Ososki played football at Fordham University a few years after Vince Lombardi, but during a time when Fordham was a nationally ranked football power. He played in the famous 1942 Sugar Bowl game in which Fordham defeated Missouri 2-0 on a blocked kick and a safety.

He served our country as a Marine in World War II, and earned distinction for his service in the Battle of Iwo Jima. After the war, he returned to Fordham University and following graduation, was drafted by the New York Football Giants.



However, a knee injury brought a quick end to his pro football career.

In 1954, he joined the faculty of Fordham Prep and spent the rest of his career at the Prep until retirement in 1984. His teams at Fordham Prep were undefeated in two out of his first three years as coach and his 1962 team were the Catholic Football Conference champions. He was named Journal American Coach of the Year in 1958.

Over the years at Fordham Prep, he held the positions of varsity football coach, varsity baseball coach, Physical Education Department Chairman, and Athletic Director.

BRUCE BOTT

Bruce had an outstanding football career at the Prep, coached by fellow Hall of Fame Inductee Joe Ososki. When he was just a sophomore, Bruce led the 1956 squad to an undefeated season that was capped by a 1-point victory over archrival Xavier in the Thanksgiving Day game. He was an All-City quarterback and won the *New York Journal American's* Lou Gehrig Award and the New York City Mayor's Citation as an outstanding scholar-athlete. Bruce returned to the Prep in 1967 as a teacher and coach. Bruce's teams on the gridiron compiled a



78-50-6 record, including a league championship. He was named the All-Star Coach in 1984. He was inducted into the Catholic High School Athletic Association Hall of Fame in 2002

Over the years at Fordham Prep, he was a history teacher, athletic director, Director of the Higher Achievement Program, Dean of Students, basketball coach, and most importantly for today's ceremony, football coach.

We hope all of you will consider joining us in March of 2015 when we formally induct these two distinguished gentlemen into the Fordham Prep Football Hall of Fame.


Voluntary Support Summary FY 2014






